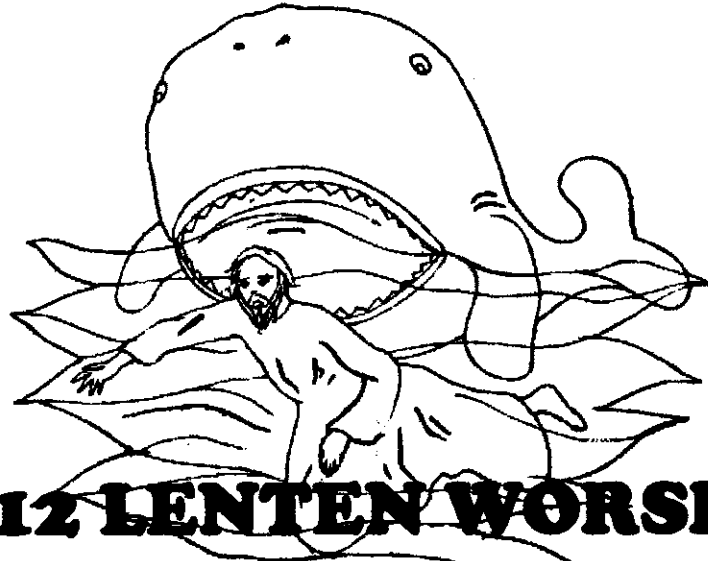

THE LONG-AWAITED PROJECTION SCREENS

The long-awaited projection screens are installed and will be used weekly for our worship. While they are a helpful tool, the screens are not the focus of our worship. To help understand the function of the screens, consider the following:

- ❖ Fears have been voiced that it will seem like coming to a movie theater instead of coming to church. At no time during worship will the screens be blank. Images used as banners will fit the seasons of the church year. Service elements, sermon aids and other images will be implemented with discretion by the team responsible for worship planning.
- ❖ The types of images and material used on the screens will progress over time. We will begin rather simply as we learn to use the system. An infinite number of possibilities exist for use on the screens. As we explore and evaluate items used, changes will occur over time.
- ❖ The screens will be used in a manner that aids the worship at Christ Lutheran Church. Congregations in other communities may use a projection system in a completely different manner.
